Collaboration with South Central Regional Medical Center  
To Offer Voluntary Vaccinations at School***

The Jones County School District is pleased to announce a partnership with our local partner, South Central Regional Medical Center, to offer voluntary vaccines on the campus of Northeast Jones High School, South Jones High School, and West Jones High School for students, faculty, staff, and community members ages twelve (12) and older.

Parents must complete and sign the Permission Form and return to the school before students will be considered for inclusion in this voluntary vaccination program.

Permission forms will be sent home with students on Monday, August 16, 2021, and must be returned to the school nurse on or before Wednesday, August 18, 2021. See below for the schedule of the voluntary vaccinations to be offered.

**First course of the voluntary Pfizer vaccine will be offered as follows:**

***West Jones High School, Thursday, August 19, 2021 – 8:30 am to 11:00 am***

***Northeast Jones High School, Friday, August 20, 2021 – 8:00 am to 11:00 am***

***South Jones High School, Friday, August 20, 2021 – 12:00 pm to 2:00 pm***

All student's participating in this voluntary vaccination program must have a signed copy of the permission form to be considered for vaccination. **Parents are welcome to be present with child during vaccination.**

**The second course of the voluntary Pfizer vaccine will be offered as follows:**

***West Jones High School, Wednesday, Sept. 15, 2021 – 8:30 am to 11:00 am***

***Northeast Jones High School, Thursday, Sept. 16, 2021 – 8:00 am to 11:00 am***

***South Jones High School, Thursday, Sept. 16, 2021 – 12:00 pm to 2:00 pm***

This program is totally voluntary and contingent on parent signed permission. Additional dates may be scheduled depending on need and response. We are excited to offer this service to our community with our partner - South Central Regional Medical Center (SCRMC).
