To Offer Voluntary Vaccinations at School
(Round 2)

The Jones County School District is pleased to announce a partnership with our local partner, South Central Regional Medical Center, to offer voluntary vaccines on the campus of Northeast Jones High School, South Jones High School, and West Jones High School for students, faculty, staff, and community members ages twelve (12) and older.

Parents must complete and sign the Permission Form and return to the school before students will be considered for inclusion in this voluntary vaccination program.

Permission forms are offered by the school nurse or in the school office. Forms must be signed and returned before students will be allowed to receive the voluntary vaccines. See below for the schedule of the voluntary vaccinations to be offered.

Voluntary Pfizer vaccine will be offered as follows:

West Jones High School, Wednesday, Sept. 15, 2021 – 8:30 am to 11:00 am
Northeast Jones High School, Thursday, Sept. 16, 2021 – 8:00 am to 11:00 am
South Jones High School, Thursday, Sept. 16, 2021 – 12:00 pm to 2:00 pm

All student's participating in this voluntary vaccination program must have a signed copy of the permission form to be considered for vaccination. Parents are welcome to be present with child during vaccination.

Voluntary Pfizer vaccine will be offered as follows:

West Jones High School, Wednesday, Oct. 13, 2021 – 8:30 am to 11:00 am
Northeast Jones High School, Thursday, Oct. 14, 2021 – 8:00 am to 11:00 am
South Jones High School, Thursday, Oct. 14, 2021 – 12:00 pm to 2:00 pm
