

SCHOOL BUS TURNAROUND PROCEDURES

19-3-42 MISSISSIPPI CODE 1972 ANNOTATED

1. SUPERVISORS CANNOT BUILD A ROAD OR DRIVEWAY, ONLY REPAIR AND/OR MAINTAIN.
2. Deadline: All school bus turnarounds must be turned into the Transportation Department on or before
OCTOBER 3, 2006.
3. Form must be completed and signed by person requesting turnaround and landowner.
4. Signed by the bus driver.
5. Checked by the Transportation Department for distance (.2 miles or greater), safety and turning space.
6. If qualified the request is sent to the School Board.
7. If approved by the School Board then it goes to the Board of Supervisors.
8. After written approval of the Board of Supervisors, the county may work on and maintain driveways to private residences that are used for school bus turnarounds. However, the county is under no obligation to work on and maintain such private driveways.
9. Work is at the discretion of the Board of Supervisors, to grade gravel, shell repair, etc/or maintain private gravel or shell roads or driveways to private residences, if such roads or driveways are used for school bus turnarounds.
10. Approval by the Board of Supervisors of the school bus turnaround shall be valid and effective for the period of time that a turnaround is anticipated for use during the school year, but in no event for a period greater than one year.
11. From beginning of process until approval of Board of Supervisors may be up to 60 days.
12. A turnaround is void if the school bus does not use it on a regular basis.
