

Dear Parents and Guardians,

During school registration for this year, if you stated that your child has Asthma, Seizures, Diabetes, or an Allergy requiring emergency medication, the school is required to have physician orders on file. These action plans must be renewed at the beginning of each school year.

If your child requires a special diet related to an allergy or other health condition, a prescription diet form is needed from your physician. If you have previously provided diet information, it will be kept on file in the cafeteria until a physician's note indicates a change.

Forms are available from your school nurse, or you may print forms from the Jones County School District website at <http://www.jones.k12.ms.us/District/nurse.html>. Medication forms are also available. Please provide the appropriate medication form for any medications indicated on the action plans. If it is necessary for your child to keep emergency medication with them at all times, please have your physician fill out the Release to Carry form. Otherwise, all medication is kept in the office. For safety purposes, students are not permitted to transport medication. If you have any questions, please contact your child's school nurse.
